Find, interpret, evaluate, manage and share information



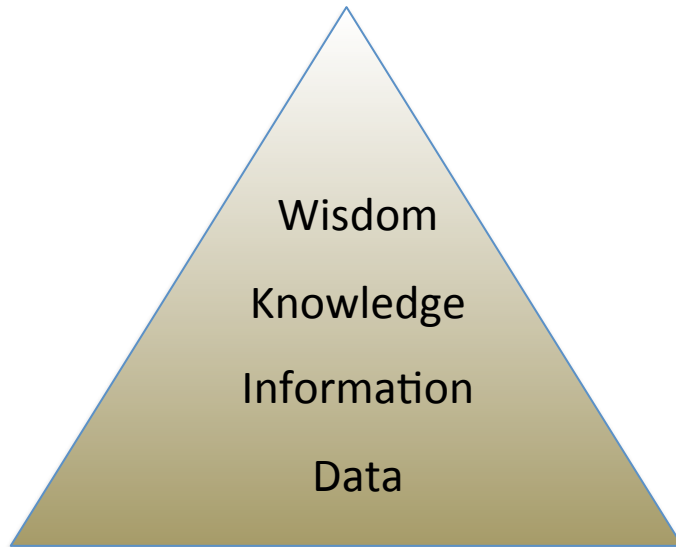

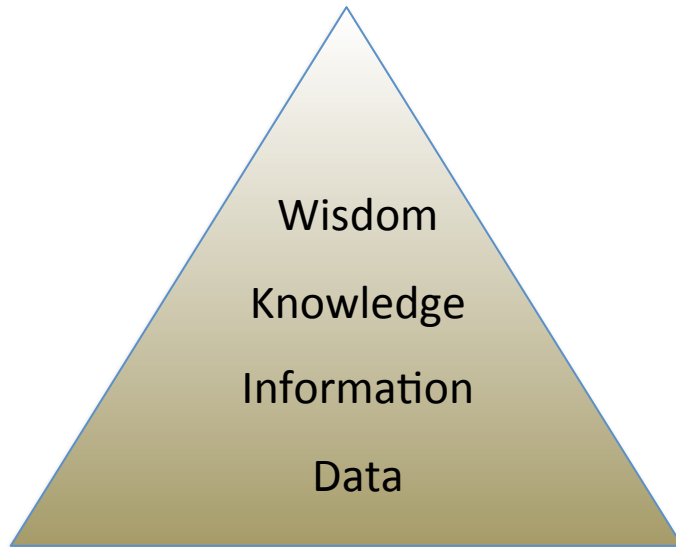
### **Acquisition:**
